GENERAL INFORMATION:

If you have a child born between 1st September 2002 and 31st August 2003, now's the time to apply for their school place. Application packs are available from Coumes Office, you must complete and return your application form no later than 31st January 2007.

As a matter of urgency, may we remind parents that they must not bring vehicles onto the school premises - except in case of emergency. The narrow access road is for staff and delivery vehicle use only and the gates are locked between 8.35-9.00am and from 3.00-3.30pm. We must ensure the health and safety of our pupils and this road is potentially very dangerous for anyone on foot.

Also, please do not arrange to meet your children in the car park or on the access road for the same reason. The children are told that they are not allowed to walk through either car parks at any time - for any reason.
