All children have taken home a plant this week. The organisers of Oughtibridge In Bloom would like to thank you for taking care of this plant for them and send the following message. 'Your little plant is just like a baby, it needs you to look after it so it can grow big and strong. There are prizes for the best kept plants, so please follow the instructions carefully:-

1. Put the plant pot on a saucer or in a container and water from the bottom.
2. Do not place the pot in a very bright window or too near a hot radiator as your little plant will get too hot.
3. Do not let the compost dry out - make sure that the compost is slightly damp at all times, but be careful not to overdo it as too much water will drown your plant.
4. Put your plant outside after the frosts have gone - this is usually early June - to get the plant ready for planting outside.
5. If possible, please give a liquid feed to the plant once a week.

Please bring your plant back to school on **Wednesday 21st June** for judging. All plants will then be planted out around the village on 25th June, ready for Yorkshire In Bloom judging in July.'
